

THE ROYAL ABBEY

In the shadows of the
Saint-Denis Cathedral Basilica,

buildings - magnificently

century by Robert de Cotte,
architect to the king are articulated around a
supremely elegant cloister.
This key site in France's
history has been home to a

boarding house founded by
Napoleon since 1805, intended
for orphans of soldiers
having received the Legion
of Honour. Still today, the
school welcomes 500 young
girls from families decorated
with the Legion of Honour,
the Military Medal or the
National Order of Merit. Come
explore this unique place
where history and architecture
come together to offer you a
captivating journey through
the centuries.

Devoured by flames during the fire of 15 April 2019 and struck by lightning between 1842 and 1845, today, the spires of the Île-de-France region are back and better than ever! Since the era of Abélard and Maurice de Sully, to the restoration of the Cathedral Basilica by the Saint-Denis local authorities, come discover these masterpieces of Gothic architecture, real testimonies to the history of France. A captivating journey through the centuries, from the heritage of Saint-Benoît to the archaeological unity of the town of Saint-Denis!

NAPOLEON : HERITAGE BETWEEN SAINT-DENIS AND PARIS

What remains of Napoleon's heritage? Explore the unique link between Paris and Saint-Denis in a day dedicated to the Emperor. In 1805, Napoleon saved the Saint-Denis Abbey from destruction by founding the second Maison d'Éducation de la Légion d'honneur there, a place loaded with history and tranquillity at the

heart of an unsuspecting, green setting. Continue your discovery at Les Invalides in Paris, where the Army Museum retraces Napoleon's life and accomplishments. The highlight of this tour takes place under the Dôme Church, opposite the Emperor's majestic tomb, sculpted by Visconti.



BOHEMIAN LIFE FROM THE FLEA MARKET TO THE ARTISTS

Set off on a bohemian escape to Montmartre, just a stone's throw from the famous Saint-Ouen-sur-Seine flea market, and relive the artistic atmosphere of the 19th century. Discover Montmartre beyond its Place du Tertre and the Sacré-Cœur, a neighbourhood brought to life by artists, cabarets and singers. Your guide will immerse you in the history of the famous mills, of which

some have become popular
ballrooms and legendary
cabarets. Next, explore the
Saint-Ouen-sur-Seine flea
market, a real treasure for
lovers of art and antiques.
Stroll between the stalls and
shops searching for that rare
pearl, as you discover the
unique know-how of restorers,
framers and second-hand
dealers, preserving
and breathing life into
our heritage.



THE ATHLETES' VILLAGE AN ECO-FRIENDLY NEIGHBOURHOOD

The Athletes' Village is, just like the Paris 2024 Games. eco-friendly and responsible.

Built to welcome athletes from around the world, the Village was designed to be transformed into a neighbourhood of residential and office units

after the Paralympic Games. Using recycled elements for its public spaces, wooden structures for buildings and a geothermal and photovoltaic network for energy production, it therefore contributes to the development of the region in which it is constructed.

FROM PLEYEL TO THE STADE DE FRANCE, RECONNECTING A FRAGMENTED TERRITORY

The Plaine Saint-Denis, once a major industrial hub, has long been marked by the deindustrialisation of the 1950s.

The region, fragmented by transport infrastructure linking the entire country, has now been transformed under the impulse of the 2024 Paris Games.

This redevelopment is aligned with the concept of 'compatible fragments' defined in the 1990s. During this walk between the Pleyel neighbourhood and the Stade de France, you'll discover how industrial or transport zones have been connected to create a new place of life in the Plaine Saint-Denis.



PLEYEL URBAN CROSSING

The Stade de France
neighbourhood, already
transformed following the
1998 World Cup, has seen a
new evolution with the 2024
Paris Games. To the west,
the Pleyel neighbourhood
long marked by a rusting
tower is reinventing itself.
This great urban project,
which will continue
after 2024, has seen

the inauguration of the futuristic train station designed by Kengo Kuma and the spectacular Pleyel urban bridge, offering exceptional views over Greater Paris.

Dive into the heart of this transformation, from the traces of its industrial past to the Athletes' Village!

FROM THE MEDIA VILLAGE TO THE STADE DE FRANCE BY BIKE

Have the 2024 Paris Games truly marked the Plaine
Commune region and, more broadly, Seine-Saint-Denis as a whole? To judge it for yourself, join us for a bike ride across four key towns: Saint-Denis, La Courneuve, Dugny and Le Bourget.
Setting off from La Plaine-Stade de France, you'll have the chance to admire the

Stade de France and the
Olympic Aquatic Centre,
as well as the Lucie Bréard
footbridge overlooking the
Saint-Denis canal.
From the Marville sports park
to the Annette Kellermann
pool, right through to the
Dugny Media Village, get up
close and personal with the
iconic sites that got hearts
pumping during the Games!



FROM LA VILLETTE TO THE ATHLETES' VILLAGE BY BIKE

From the La Villette park, hop on your bike and set off on an adventure along the Saint-Denis canal and the Seine, key routes for the 2024 Paris Games. Head off along a cycle path redeveloped for the occasion, while admiring the works of the Street Art Avenue. The perfect
